Experience and Career Activities

Now , I'm a lecturer in the curriculum and Teaching department , Assiut Faculty of Education , Assiut University

1)I joined Riyadh Community College in September, 2006. Since then, I have been teaching in both the transfer and the career

programs. I taught many linguistics subjects including Linguistics 1 & 2, phonetics and other skill – based subjects. I also taught many ESP courses for non English major students including medical students, nursing students and other business and accounting majors.

2) For one academic year (2005/2006), I worked as the Acting Director General and the Academic Advisor of Al Rowad International Schools in Riyadh. The school hired only British and American teachers to prepare its students for International Board Exams in the American SAT and the British IGSSC.

3) From 1994 until 2005, I worked for Riyadh Teacher s' College as an Assistant professor in the English Department. During this long period (11 years), I was assigned by the Ministry of Education as a member of the committee for designing the BA programs for the English Language Departments (about 11 departments) in the Teachers' Colleges in the Kingdom.

4) I also participated in designing the programs of training for the Diploma programs (General English Diploma and the Diploma for teaching English in the Elementary Schools) for the Community Center in the Teachers 'College in Riyadh. I participated in designing the material for these programs.

5) I was also the academic coordinator of these programs for two years.

6) I participated in the evaluation of the tentative copies of primary school textbooks for grade six in the Ministry of Education.

7) I was a permanent member of the Selection Committee of the Teaching Assistants for the English Departments in the Teachers' Colleges assigned by the Ministry of Education.

8) I taught many skill-based courses for the undergraduates including, listening, speaking, reading and writing.

I also taught many Linguistics courses ; Applied Linguistics , Syntax , Phonetics , second language acquisition , psycholinguisticsetc

9) I supervised trainees' Teaching Practice both in Egypt and in the Kingdom in Intermediate and Secondary schools.

10) I taught many non English major courses (ESP) both inside and outside the Kingdom; for medical, general science , computer and Arabic students

11) I chaired the English Department in Riyadh Teachers' College for one year, in 1423 and once again during the Summer School of 1425. From 1421 until 1426, I was the deputy head and the coordinator of the Department.

12) In 1991-1992, I was hired by Sana'a University, Republic of Yemen, faculty of Education, English Department.

12) Before that, I worked for Assiut Faculty of Education, Assiut University as a Lecturer from 1988 until 1994.

During that period (from 1988 through 1994), I supervised and co-supervised 3MA and 2PhD projects. These were mostly in the area of English Language teaching for speakers of other languages and English teacher trainees.
